Activities:

- Weeding and general garden maintenance
- Application of mulch or ground cover
- Planting or transplanting
- Trimming bushes or small trees

- Ability to work independently with minor supervision
- Ability to handle minor physical work
- Ability to work in a safe and effective manner
- Gardening skills helpful but not required
- Training will be provided by the Children's Museum
- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Valid Police Vulnerable Sector Check required
